## ~ CRA BOARD SUMMARY ~ FIRST AMENDMENT TO CRA/CITY INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT FOR FUNDING CONSTRUCTION/PROFESSIONAL SERVICES FY 2016-2017

At its meeting of September 22, 2016, the CRA Board adopted the FY 2016-17 Budget and approved the Interlocal Agreement with the City of Delray Beach for funding of Joint Projects for Fiscal Year 2016-2017. Per the Agreement, funds will be transferred to the City at the time that a contract is awarded or service authorization (consultant agreement) is approved for each project.

Attached is Amendment #1 to the ILA reflecting the changes, as well as other adjustments as explained in more detail below. It is noted that for many of the projects, funding has been increased, based on the actual cost of either the design fees or construction services related to the projects.

The following summarizes the above as well as modifications to the items listed in Exhibit "A" of the attached Interlocal Agreement, consistent with Budget Amendment #1. Line items were increased as follows based on updated design costs, construction cost estimates, and/or actual construction costs:

- #1 Block 8 Alley (South of W Atlantic Ave SW 10<sup>th</sup>/11<sup>th</sup> Aves) Increased (\$30,000) for actual construction costs.
- #5 Parking Study Implementation (E. Atlantic Avenue Crosswalk Upgrades Venetian/Gleason) Increased (\$16,000) for additional design costs associated with FDOT design and permitting requirements.
- #9 Block 63 Alley Increased (\$40,000) for additional design (\$6,500) and construction costs (\$33,500) associated with sewer main replacement and drainage improvements.
- #10 SW Neighborhood Alleys (5 Alleys) Increased (\$110,000) for additional design and construction costs associated with sewer main replacement and drainage improvements.

The adopted FY 2016-17 CRA Work Plan will be changed accordingly.

#### **Recommended Action:**

Approve the First Amendment to the Interlocal Agreement with the City of Delray Beach for funding of Construction/Professional Services for Fiscal Year 2016-17.

# FIRST AMENDMENT TO THE INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF DELRAY BEACH AND THE DELRAY BEACH COMMUNITY REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY FOR FUNDING CONSTRUCTION/PROFESSIONAL SERVICES FY 2016-2017

THIS FIRST AMENDMENT TO THE INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT FOR FUNDING OF
CONSTRUCTION/PROFESSIONAL SERVICES ("FIRST AMENDMENT") is made this
day of, 2017, by and between the CITY OF DELRAY BEACH, a
Florida municipal corporation, (hereinafter referred to as "CITY"), and the DELRAY BEACH
COMMUNITY REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY, a public body corporate and politic, duly created
and operated pursuant to Chapter 163, Florida Statutes (hereinafter referred to as the "CRA").

#### WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, the CITY and the CRA entered into an Interlocal Agreement for the Funding of Construction/Professional Services for Fiscal Year 2016-2017, on November 1, 2016 (the "Original Agreement"), which provided for funding for construction and professional services for projects within the Community Redevelopment Area; and

WHEREAS, the CRA and the CITY desire to enter into this First Amendment to the Original Agreement (the "First Amendment") in order to amend Exhibit "A" to the Original Agreement, to provide for changes in the amount of funding for the projects listed in Exhibit "A" to the Original Agreement.

**NOW, THEREFORE**, in consideration of the mutual covenants and promises herein contained, the parties hereby agree as follows:

- 1. The recitations set forth above are hereby incorporated herein.
- 2. The CRA and the CITY agree to amend Exhibit "A" to the Original Agreement, to reflect the changes in the amount of funding provided by the CRA for Fiscal Year 2016-17 for the projects listed in Exhibit "A" to the Original Agreement. The revisions to Exhibit "A", are consistent with the CRA's Budget Amendment No. 1 for FY 2016-17.
- 3. Subject to the availability of funds, and annual budgeting and appropriation by the CRA, the CRA will provide additional funding for the projects listed in Exhibit "A" in Fiscal Year

#### 2016-17.

- 4. The CITY and the CRA agree that Exhibit "A" to the Original Agreement is hereby amended as provided in Exhibit "A" to this First Amendment, which is attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference.
- 5. All other terms and conditions of the Original Agreement not in conflict with this First Amendment shall remain in full force and effect.
