What is your gender?



If you live or work in Delray Beach, what is your zipcode?



Do you have children or grandchildren that visit or want to visit Old School Square?



What is your mode of transportation when visiting OSS?



Do you find it difficult to find parking when attending an event at OSS?



Are there sufficient means of public transportation to OSS?





Are handicap accessible routes and drop offs a current problem for you?

















Do you feel that OSS, through it's current operations, supports your vision for the City and OSS?





Do you feel the park is under utilized or over utilized?



Do you feel safe when visiting the park at night?



Should the park have more or less shade trees?



Should the park have more pavement/hard surfaces?



Does OSS contributre to the virbant small town character of Delray Beach?




