Old School Square Master Plan January 18, 2017

Programming Categories:

1. Add seating and tables

- Moveable/permanent around trees at different levels, at Crest Theatre
- Playground seating
- Rocking chairs as kinetic art
- Café seating at corners
- Flexible seating, north and south of site
- Small Group Settings
- Add trash receptacles

2. Landscaping

- Replace non-native plants
- Add grass and shade areas
- Add orchids/native plants/flowers for butterfly garden
- Movable planting boxes
- Remove and relocate two large trees for view opening
- Trim and lift trees (site lines)
- Relocate palm trees to park
- Add canopy trees
- Remove and relocate royal palms
- Incorporate artificial turf on south side of Cornell Museum
- Change gravel to grass
- Use pots to bring color to Cornell entrance

3. Lighting

- Lighting to buildings and entry area (Cornell Museum) for night shows with seating
- Up-light trees

- Add string lighting at entry
- Light water element
- Fun light in arched walkway
- Visually appealing lighting that blends with space
- Add light for safety and cleanliness

4. Water feature

- Interactive fountains
- Splash garden
- Water feature with seating surrounding

5. Signage

- Add informational kiosk/voice activated kiosk/entry kiosk
- Directional and interactive
- Signage for current exhibit
- Check-in Desk

6. Pets

- Doggie drinking fountain
- Dog park
- Pet Shows

7. Children

- Children's play area
- Playground seating

8. Public Art

- Wall murals
- Piped in music
- Add artwork/kinetic art/Rocking Chairs
- Chalk board/graffiti wall
- Open space for artists to work/musicians to play/Dancing/Tai Chi/Yoga
- Play up little boy statue
- Install landmark pieces of art
- Lighting art shows on garage wall

9. Food/Sales

- Ice cream cart
- Permanent pad for revolving restaurants (food trucks)
- Rooftop dining on parking garage
- Green market improvement (night time use)
- Pop-up storefronts for books
- Coffee Stand
- Flower Sales
- Add trash receptacles

10. Transportation/connectivity

- Create downtown roundabout "stop" in front of museum
- Add a car pull out for drop off or OSS valet for special events
- Bus stop/trolley stop – drop off at Cornell Museum
- Add bike racks
- Glass elevator on south west corner of garage
- Safe crosswalks
- Art Crosswalks

11. Shade

- Add umbrellas for shade
- Covered trellis for tables or pathways
- Central gazebo

12. Environmental Sustainability

- Solar power outlets
- Solar panels to power lights
- FPL Solar Trees
- LEED concepts (LEED platinum)
- Zeroscape/Florida friendly landscaping
- Renewable materials
- Eco Art

13. Year Round Outdoor Performance Space

- Intermediate (retractable) roof system for pavilion
- Paved area at pavilion
- Grass amphitheater seating

14. Be Creative...(Write in your idea)

- Remove and replace restrooms
- Relocate Christmas tree
- Open ground floor parking garage for flexible activity
- Custom removable stage
- Trade Lessons
- Commercial Borders/Partnerships
- Additional Suggestions???

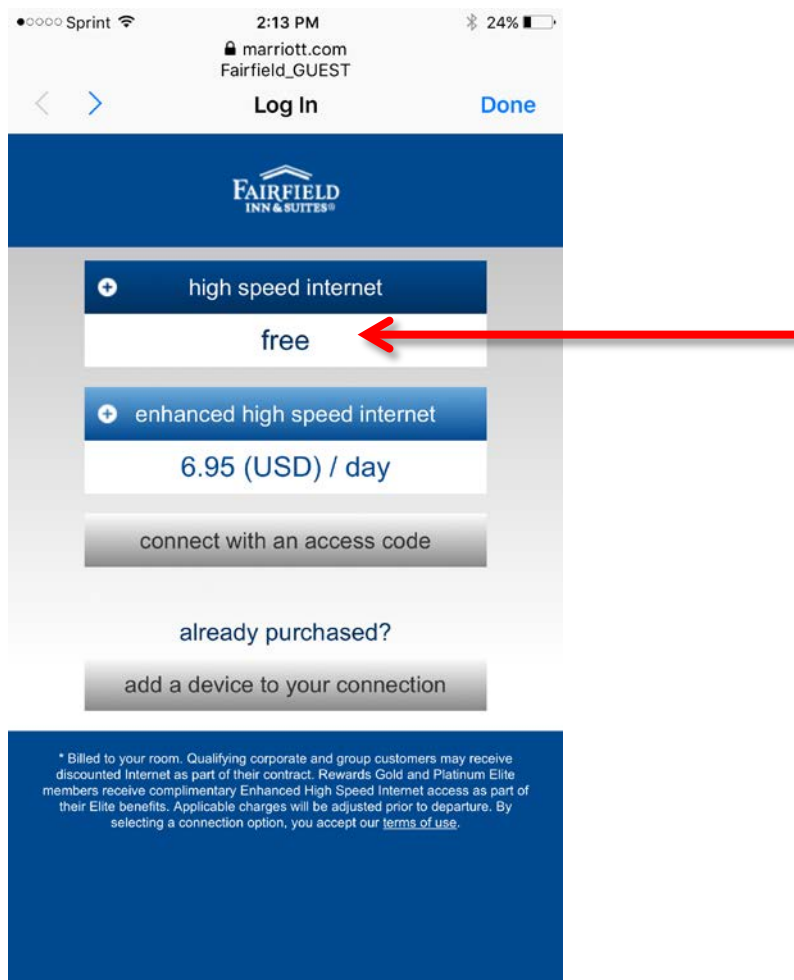

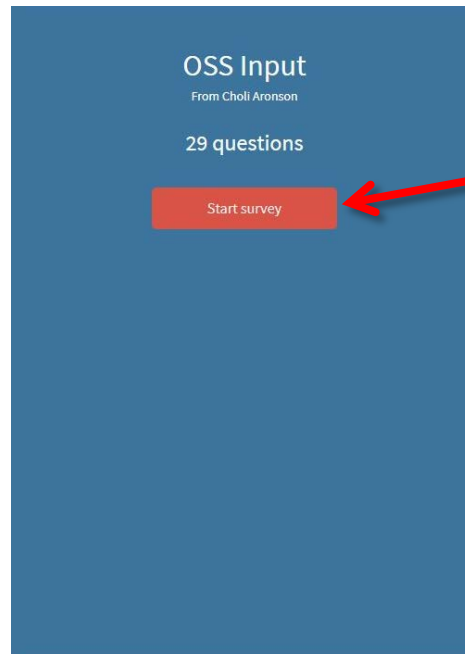

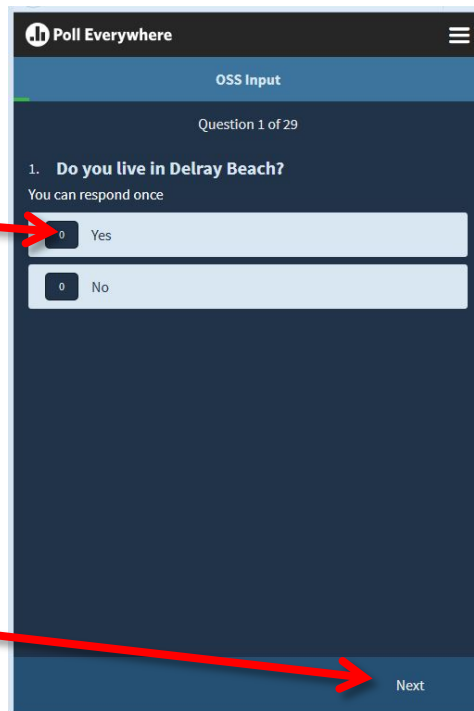
