3.1 SCOPE

The awarded Bidder shall provide all labor, equipment, materials, and other operations to construct the CRA Office Renovations Project, in accordance with the Specifications, plans, drawings and other documents contained in this RFB. The Delray Beach CRA estimates the total costs to construct this project will not exceed \$100,000 \$150,000.00.

QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS:

- 1. Q: "Do you have a budget for this project?"
 - A: The estimated project cost is \$150,000.00.
- 2. Q: Is the contractor responsible for moving furniture to paint the interior of the building?
 - A: The CRA will move the furniture to the center of each room. The contractor is responsible for protecting the furniture while painting.
- 3. Q: Is the replacement of the decorative shutters in the allowance or in the specifications?
 - A: All existing shutters are to be removed and replaced with new wood shutters and this scope in to be included in the base bid.
- 4. Q: What is the provision for Liquidated Damages?
 - A: The Liquidated Damages provision is set at Seventy-Five Dollars (\$75) per day.
