Pursuant to Section 163.380, Florida Statutes, notice is hereby given that the Delray Beach Community Redevelopment Agency (CRA) intends to lease three (3) CRA-owned commercial spaces to three (3) qualified individuals or entities for commercial uses with daytime, nighttime, and weekend operating hours.

The CRA-owned properties are located at:

- 135 NW 5th Avenue, Unit C5 Delray Beach, FL 33444 (West Settlers Building)
 - o Unit is approximately 875SF
 - o \$21 per square foot for Unit C5 (approx. \$1,531.25 per month)
 - Access to public parking
- 98 NW 5th Avenue, Units 103 and 104, Delray Beach, FL 33444 (Edmond Baines Building)
 - o Each unit is approximately 650SF
 - o \$18 per square foot for Units 103 & 104 (approx. \$975 per month)
 - Access to public parking

The CRA-owned properties are located along the historic NW 5th Avenue corridor within the West Settlers Historic District. This area was once a vital commercial and institutional corridor comprised of black-owned businesses in the heart of the City of Delray Beach's African American neighborhood. The CRA is committed to curating a diverse and interesting mix of business offerings within the buildings and along historic NW/SW 5th Avenue that meets the needs of the surrounding community based on the 2012 West Atlantic Area Needs Assessment and the West Atlantic Master Plan (aka The Set Transformation Plan).
